Rules: WKF, KFS modified KUP SYSTEM includes two third places without rematch, . .

- **KUMITE INDIVIDUAL** : According to the rules of the KFS - At the tournament itself, depending on the number of registered competitors by category and only with the consent of the competition delegate, it is possible to combine weight categories.
- **KATE TEAM**: A mixed team is allowed in the age group of runners, pioneers and hopefuls (2 boys + 1 girl and vice versa) the performance of one younger competitor is allowed in team katas in an older age group.
- **INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM CATEGORIES**: Article 21 of the KFS competition regulations applies
- Competitors can perform in their belt and absolute level
- Competitors from E and D class (yellow and orange belts) perform pre-apprentice and apprentice katas and can repeat a kata in every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively.
- Class C competitors (green belts) perform student and teki katas and can repeat a kata every fourth round (must know at least three katas) and cannot repeat the same kata consecutively. Competitors from class B (blue belts) perform apprentice, teki and master kata, a new kata in each round, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- Competitors from the A class (brown belts) perform master katas, a new kata in each round, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively. Competitors in the absolute level in the age categories of pioneers and hopefuls perform katas from the official Kata list (KFS and WKF), in each round a new kata, and in the age category of runners they perform katas from the official Kata list (KFS and WKF) and can repeat the kata in each round in the fourth round (they must know at least three kata) where they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively.
- For team katas for pole-starters, pioneers and hopefuls, katas from the official Kata list (KFS and WKF) are performed. Poletarians can repeat a kata every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively, and pioneers can repeat a kata every fourth round (must know at least three katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata repeat consecutively. In the hope age category, competitors perform a new kata in each round, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively.
- Class C cadets (yellow and orange belts) perform pre-apprentice and apprentice katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list and can repeat the kata in every third round (must know at least two katas), whereby they cannot repeat the same kata consecutively.
- Class B cadets (green and blue belts) perform apprentice, teki and master katas from the official WKF and KFS Kata list in each round of a new kata, with the fact that in the fight for a medal they can repeat the kata from the eliminations, but not consecutively

(selection is made from one of the categories: cadets, juniors, seniors)

(pioneers, hopefuls, cadets, juniors, seniors and veterans)

OBLIGATIONS OF COMPETITORS:

- Protective equipment according to WKF rules. Trainers are responsible for the health condition of their competitors. The organizer of the competition bears no responsibility in case of injuries to competitors.
- All competitors in the KUMITE, in the categories: female cadets, juniors and seniors, must have a chest protector in addition to body protectors.
- All younger competitors in KUMITE (pioneers) up to the age of hope can wear a protective vest over a kimono.
- All registered competitors are required to have a competition accreditation, a medical examination not older than 6 months, as well as a valid insurance policy. Clubs from abroad must have confirmation from their national association that they are registered members of the WKF organization.
- A competitor in the individual competition can only compete in his age group.
